



Kíds4Keeps

Dear Methodist Church

Below is a list of the types of things we have been able to do to support families with using the generous Kids4Keeps donations.

Household maintenance-items for cleaning (often unsafe conditions), treatments for insects, organization items (helps with care of children and safety in the home)

Home safety-items to make the home physically safer for children including gates, door alarms and latches, smoke alarm.

Personal care- items that the family needs for personal care. Often this is a secondary need but important for parents to get/keep a job or interact with others.

Family activities that allow parents to spend fun quality time with children- ex fishing license, toys

Work related- often assistance with getting driver's license to get to work to maintain income

Groceries- food supply in home is not appropriate and could contribute to removal of children

Miscellaneous-laundry, food when meeting with kids by themselves (like ice cream or McDonalds)

This is an overall idea of ways we can support families. We have used the donation to keep families together and to get kids back home and stay home. We are so grateful for the support of the United Methodist members/Mission Committee! Thank you does not begin to convey our heartfelt joy when we know using this donation will keep kids with parents or get them home.

Short Term Volunteers in Mission

Mauston Methodist Church Led Trips

Nome, Alaska - July 19th - 27th, 2024 ~ We are building a team of 12 volunteers for a nine day return trip to Nome, where the need is immense. We work with the Nome Community Center on projects that help the low income and homeless population. Skilled and non-skilled construction volunteers needed. Lodging will be on air mattresses/army cots in the church classrooms. Showers in the community center. Youth must be in 6th grade or above, unless accompanied by a parent/guardian. Cost \$1,350.00, includes travel from Minneapolis, lodging and meals on workdays. (Not included 4 meals and excursion costs) Deposit of \$650 is due with registration by April 10th. Final payment due by May 15th.

Hazard, Kentucky - August 24th - 31st, 2024 ~ Seven or Eight-day trip; working with the Housing Development Alliance in Perry County, Kentucky. On July 27, 2022, a flood swept through 14 counties in East Kentucky, killing 45 people and displacing thousands more. The area hit by the flood is one of the most rural regions in the country. Two years later, the affected communities remain on the road to recovery. Work will involve light carpentry on home repairs or home rebuilds. Skilled and non-skilled construction volunteers needed. Lodging on air mattresses in church classrooms. Showers in the community center. Youth must be 14 years old, unless accompanied by a parent/guardian.

Option #1: Cost \$550.00, includes travel from Mauston, lodging and meals on workdays. One overnight in hotel and visit to the Ark Encounter. (Not included 6 meals and excursion costs)

Option #2: Cost \$350.00, includes lodging and meals on workdays. (Not included travel and excursion costs) Deposit of \$275 (option #1) / \$175 (option #2) is due with registration by June 16^{th} . Final payment due by July 10^{th} .
